Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that:
1	The total number of sections of Bal vatika shall be restricted to 3 (1 each for Bal Vatika I, II & III respectively). The total number of sections from classes I to XII shall be restricted to 18. The total number of sections taken together for classes XI and XII should not be more than 1/3 of the number of section allowed including Bal Vtika. Any further increase shall require prior permission of the Board and shall be subject to compliance with the affiliation Bye laws and availability of rooms of >500 sq ft dimensions.
2	The CWSN facilities like ramp/lift to access upper floors are not available. However the school has shown the provision for installation of lift. Hence the school is directed to complete the installation work of lift and submit the videographic compliance within 3 months.
3	The school has converted regular cubicles into CWSN toilets which are too small and narrow and there is no room for a wheelchair/walker to navigate. The grab bars are incorrectly placed. Thus the school shall construct separate toilets for CWSN, boys and girls on every floor with proper permanent signage as per norms of RPwD Act and

	guidelines issued by the Board within 3 months and submit compliance on SARAS with videography.
4	The fully equipped composite lab for secondary level is not seen in the RC video. Hence the school is directed to setup composite lab for secondary level as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the videographic compliance within 3 months.
5	Maths lab is seen understocked and looking like a make shift arrangement. There is no permanent workstations and adequate seating arrangement. Physics lab does not have seating arrangement. Chemistry lab does not have exhaust fans and fire extinguisher. The water connections are not in the demonstration tables. Biology lab does not have permanent workstations with appropriate fixture / installations like sinks/water connections on the demonstration table. There is not seating arrangement in the lab. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the labs as per SoPs issued by the Board and submit the videographic compliance within 3 months.
6	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Bhubaneswar within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII, as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye Laws-2018.
- 2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
- 3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
- 4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., http://cbseacademic.nic.in/ & http://cbse.nic.in/ for updates.
- 5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
